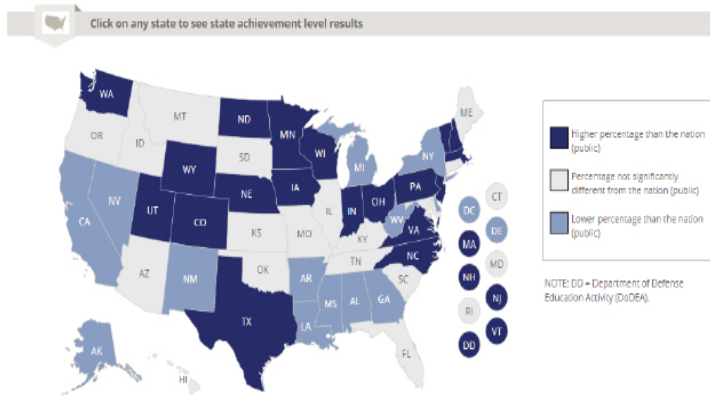

Between 26 and 54 percent of fourth-graders perform at or above *Proficient* across states/jurisdictions

In 2015, the percentages of fourth-grade public school students performing at or above the *Proficient* level in mathematics ranged from 26 percent to 54 percent across the states/jurisdictions. The percentage of fourth-grade public school students performing at or above *Proficient* was 39 percent nationally.
